Matthew 11:2-11

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or REALife Group.

Review: Doubts are fine...if they lead you to find out.
Doubts are fatal...if they leave you in limbo.

Ask God an honest question.

1. Am I willing to examine the source of my doubts?
2. Am I willing to accept that my circumstances may not change?

Believe an honest answer from God.

1. God is not angry with your questions.
2. God will provide evidence of His plan at work.
3. God promises blessing to those who believe.

1. What are some of the doubts you face about God and faith? Would you say these are fleeting doubts or plaguing doubts?

2. Were you surprised to know that someone like John the Baptist had doubts? Why do you think God included stories like this in the Bible?

3. What are some of the sources of doubt? Is it possible to have clear evidence before you and still doubt? Tell of a time when you experienced this.

4. Do you believe that God wants to meet you in your doubt and lead you into belief? Do you have a running partner or a supportive group to help you explore faith issues?
